Through the recent residents survey, we heard that almost half of you said you would have liked more one-to-one conversations with the engagement team.

REFLECTING ON THE 2020 BALLOT

There were lots of positives, residents loved the proposals for green spaces, better facilities, and over 50% of residents liked the new homes.

Since 2017, we have been engaging with residents of Juniper Crescent and Gilbeys Yard estates to explore the opportunity to provide better and new homes, community facilities and open green spaces.

The proposals for this were put to a ballot vote in June 2020, so that residents could have their say on the proposals for redevelopment. It has now been a year since residents voted on the proposals and we last met face to face.

As well as the positive feedback on the proposals, residents said that there wasn't quite enough information about a number of aspects and important details, and almost half of residents said they would have liked more face-to-face conversations with the team about these issues.





RESIDENT BALLOT OUTCOME AND FEEDBACK

Between October 2020 and February 2021 we reached out to residents for feedback on the ballot and Landlord Offer.





BEST BITS

Of you were satisfied and understood your tenancy rights would remain the same as they currently are.

Of you liked the design and layout of the new development.

Of you felt the new development would have provided a better living situation for you / and your family.

Of you felt that your ideas for the new development had been taken into consideration.

Of you told us that more face- to-face and one-toone interactions with the team would have helped with questions you may have had, especially during the voting period.

Of you felt unsure or dissatisfied with the information presented on service charges for new homes in the new development.

Of you have said that you would have liked more consultation events to speak with the Regeneration team.

Of you told us that you were unsure or dissatisfied with the size of the proposed gardens or balcony.

AREAS FOR IMPROVEMENT

As we move forward with the engagement process, we would like to take a step back from the design and architecture process to carry out a period of reflection, focusing on what we can learn from your experiences over the past year, which is our key priority as we reengage with residents.

To carry out this reflective engagement, we have organised a series of coffee catch ups that will take place over the months of July and August 2021, during which we would like to focus on building a relationship with you.

When it comes to Juniper Crescent and Gilbey's Yard, residents will always be integral to any decision making.

One Housing and Countryside are dedicated to providing great homes and places for residents and future generations to live both in the immediate and long-term future. We would still like to look at regeneration going forward but not without answering the questions you may feel were not answered previously and to provide all residents with clarity.

We are excited to announce that we will be creating two welcoming community coffee hubs at both estates and will be ready for residents soon! Updates will be made to the existing Gilbeys Yard portacabin and a new space being put in place on Juniper Crescent.

The Juniper Crescent portacabin will be located next to the roundabout on unused land. The existing trees and shrubbery will be transplanted to a new location, so you will see us out and about in the coming days preparing the space. We will engage with any households affected directly before installation begins.

Based on feedback we received from residents we decided to create a comfortable space for residents to drop in for a coffee and have sit down one-to-one conversations with the team.

We look forward welcoming residents in the coming months!
